These two sessions will gather panel of industry experts to discuss isolation techniques and considerations of critical importance to power source designers

- “Improvements of Partial Discharge Screening Results”

Session IS09, covering isolation in power supply applications, will take place on Wednesday, March 7, from 8:30 a.m. to 10:10 a.m. This session comprises the following presentations by four industry experts:

- “Isolation in Power Supply”
- “Powering Devices Across the Isolation Barrier”
- “Increased Power Density Through Capacitive Conversion”
- “Isolation Techniques Without an Isolator”
